



## Entrepreneurship and Innovation Minor Course Planning Worksheet

Any undergraduate student at MSU can earn a minor in entrepreneurship and innovation, regardless of their major or which college they are enrolled in.

Requirements:

**15 credit-hours**, with at least six of them being unique to the Minor. That is, they cannot be used to fulfill another university, college or major requirement.

- **Required Core Courses** (*it is recommended that students take the core courses in the Minor first*)  
 ESHP 190: The Art of Starting, 3 credits  
 CAS/AL 114: Creativity and Entrepreneurship, 3 credits

- **Completion of two Entrepreneurship and Innovation Experiences Options.** More information can be found at <http://eship.msu.edu/experiences> . An experience must be completed in a course that does not count toward the Minor.
