Any undergraduate student at MSU can earn a minor in entrepreneurship and innovation, regardless of their major or which college they are enrolled in.

Requirements:

15 credit-hours, with at least six of them being unique to the Minor. That is, they cannot be used to fulfill another university, college or major requirement.

Required Core Courses (it is recommended that students take the core courses in the Minor first)
ESHP 190: The Art of Starting, 3 credits
CAS/AL 114: Creativity and Entrepreneurship, 3 credits
